

**Glasford Printing Company**  
**Est. 1899**

The Glasford Printing Company was founded on January 1, 1899, by W.F. Rader, who died in 1915. WF, however trained his son, Morris Rader, who came of age in 1906, and received half interest in the Glasford Gazette.

In 1909, Morris Rader became Editor and Publisher. Following his death in 1957, his wife, Kate, became Publisher, and their son, Bruce succeeded Kate, until becoming ill in 1993, at which time, William and Janet Watkins bought the paper.

The Glasford Gazette is published weekly, on Thursdays, as it always has been.
